

NAME INSERT FOR PICTURE FRAME

Draw rectangle and round corners.

Type Name with Text tool, change font style and size.

With Pick tool, change outline to red and the fill color to none.

Press Control key plus the D key to create a duplicate of the name and drag it off to the side of your work area. Change the outline color of your duplicate to black.

Select the red outlined name and drag it to the bottom of your rectangle overlapping a little. Center the text on the rectangle by holding down the shift key and also selecting the rectangle. Press C to center.

Get Shaping box by clicking on Arrange—Shaping. Change to the Intersect command and make sure there is a check in the Target Objects box. Select the red text. Click on Intersect With and then click on the rectangle. Your text should be now cut off at the rectangle.

Change to the Trim command in the Shaping box. Make sure that there are no check marks in the Source or Target boxes. Select the text and then click on Trim and click on the rectangle. Your piece should now be Trimmed.

Select the text outlined in black. Drag it over the name in the rectangle. Get it as close as your can from top to bottom. Hold the shift key down and also select the rectangle. Click on C to center left to right.
